Subject: Apportionment of Assets, Liabilities and posts of erstwhile State of J&K to the Union Territory of Ladakh.

**Government Order No. 47-JK(YSS) of 2021.**  
**Dated : 16.07.2021**

Consequent upon the issuance of S.O 339 notified on 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 by General Administration Department, sanction is hereby accorded to the apportionment of following assets/liabilities of erstwhile State of J&K to the UT of Ladakh or to an entity designated by it, with immediate effect:

**1. Transfer of funds:**

20% of Free Bank Balance/ fixed deposits excluding funds for executing works of the erstwhile J&K- State Sports Council, amounting to Rs.7.89 Crores, as has been worked out, earmarked and communicated by the Secretary, J&K- Sports Council to the UT of Ladakh or to an entity designated by it.

**2. Transfer of Vehicles / Assets:**

As SO 339 the order reads as :-

*"Transfer of Two vehicles less than five years old and immoveable property in the UT of Ladakh of the erstwhile J&K-Sports Council to the UT of Ladakh."*

- a. As communicated by the Secretary, J&K- Sports Council, the council is not in a position to transfer any vehicle to the UT of Ladakh in light of the fact that there were seven vehicles beyond five years old which got damaged due to devastating floods of 2014 and these vehicles were beyond the repairs, and their process of condemnation is under consideration.
- b. One Indoor Hall at Kargil under PMDP Scheme is under execution through JKPC and the same shall be transferred to the UT of Ladakh on its completion.
- c. Transfer of immovable assets of J&K Sports Council situated in UT of Ladakh on an "as is where is basis" to the UT of Ladakh or an entity designated by it as per the following details:-
  1. Two rooms at Old K.V. School building near PWD Office Leh allotted to J&K Sports Council during 2016-17 for setting up of Sub-Office.

2. Pavilion Block of Khree Sultan Choo Stadium, Kargil for establishment of Office cum residence of J&K- Sports Council.

**3. Apportionment of Manpower:**

Transfer of following 20 Group C posts so identified, determined and communicated by the Secretary, J&K- Sports Council, and a certain number of Group-A and B posts to be determined by the J&K Sports Council in due course of time to the UT of Ladakh or an entity designated by it.
