The study leave so granted shall be subject to the prior fulfilment of the following conditions at the Directorate level:-

- That the case is genuine and course of higher studies has due regard to the exigencies of public service and would be of definite advantage to the Department.



- ii. That there is dearth of such qualified officials in the Department.
- iii. That the Officials have no superior claim over his/their seniors for consideration for promotion after acquiring higher/additional qualification.
- iv. That the stipend, scholarship etc, if any, received during study leave shall be adjusted in his leave salary in accordance with rules.
- v. That the official has completed his period of probation satisfactorily.
- vi. That the institute as well as the course is recognized.
- vii. That the total study leave availed by the official shall not exceed 03 years during his entire service.
- viii. That all the terms and conditions as laid down in the policy issued by the Department for such type of cases vide Govt.Order No.103-Edu.(Tech.) of 2015 Dated 11.08.2015 are followed in letter and spirit and the eligibility of the official for such kind of leave is established in accordance with rules /norms before allowing the official concerned to proceed on such leave.
- ix. That all the rules/regulations/study leave rules and norms prescribed from time to time governing the instant matter are followed in letter and spirit.
- x. That the employee shall execute an indemnity bond in Form 6 or Form 7 as the case may be before the study leave granted to him/her commences.


